EP09: Receiving and Growing in Faith

In today's devotional, we'll talk about how we receive and grow in faith. I'll also give you three habits you can create in order to steward the revelation you've been given. This is episode 3 of a 5-part series on faith.

SCRIPTURES:

Romans 10:17, "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (NKJV)

Romans 10:17, "Faith, then, is birthed in a heart that responds to God's anointed utterance of the Anointed One." (TPT)

John 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." (NIV)

Romans 1:17, "This gospel unveils a continual revelation of God's righteousness—a perfect righteousness given to us when we believe. And it moves us from receiving life through faith, to the power of living by faith." (TPT)

Colossians 3:1-3, "Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand. Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God." (NLT)

John 5:19, "Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does." (NIV)

Galatians 5:24-25, "Since this is the kind of life we have chosen, the life of the Spirit, let us make sure that we do not just hold it as an idea in our heads or a sentiment in our hearts, but work out its implications in every detail of our lives." (MSG)

Hebrews 11:1-2, "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. 2 For by it the elders obtained a good testimony." (NKJV)

1. Name the three consecutive stages of receiving faith and explain why each one is vital to establishing faith within the heart?

2. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in receiving and growing in faith?

3. Define the Logos and the Rhema Word of God.

4. Why is the Rhema Word of God necessary in receiving faith?

5. What is the process of going from faith to faith? (hint: revelation)

6. Name and define the three habits a believer must have to steward the revelation they receive?
